- AP will use the following public testimony time limits for this special meeting (same as the Council, different than the normal AP):





- 3 minutes for individuals or companies

- Visual timer for oral testimony
- 1. Sign up through the SSC eAgenda, next to the agenda item you want to testify on
- 2. Fill out the form with your personal details
- 3. Attach handouts or ppts if desired. (Staff can project upon request.)
- 4. Identify whether remote/in-person.
 - If remote, please ensure a strong internet connection and be in a quiet area.
 - If calling from a phone, use that number on the signup form so we can unmute you
